## Fora Health provides treatment, care and advocacy for all who are affected by substance use disorder.

### Medically Managed Withdrawal

Patients spend 1-5 days onsite and receive 24/7 support to withdraw from alcohol, opiates and stimulants.

#### Medication to Treat Addiction

Patients work with an addiction counselor and prescriber to explore medications that can reduce withdrawal symptoms and cravings.

#### Medically Monitored Residential Treatment

SUD treatment for those with severe co-occurring medical and/or psychiatric needs. (also called 3.7 on the ASAM Level of Care Continuum)

#### Residential Treatment

Patients live onsite and receive 24/7 care for SUD and co-occurring mental health disorders. Individuals are assigned to programs based on the gender to which they most closely align.

#### Outpatient Services

Patients live offsite and access treatment one or more times per week. Intensive Outpatient is also available.

#### Family Therapy

Interested patients are referred to family therapy and can invite loved ones into treatment.

#### Peer Recovery Mentors

Patients enrolled in residential and outpatient care have access to support, skill building and a wealth of activities curated by professional Peer Recovery Mentors.

#### **DUII Services**

Flexible outpatient program for DUII Diversion and Conviction.
