MAT Medications

- Buprenorphine (most common brand names Suboxone and Subutex) for opioid use disorder
- Naltrexone tablets and Vivitrol® injection
- Injectable form of Buprenorphine, called Sublocade® and Brixadi®
- Naloxone (Narcan), the medication that reverses an opioid overdose
