



Outpatient Medication to Treat Addiction (MAT)

Do you want to take medications to help you stop using drugs, or reduce your use? Come talk with us! We offer medications for substance use such as buprenorphine (also known as Suboxone or Subutex) and naltrexone. Our care team can find a medication that can help you feel better, reduce cravings and reduce withdrawal.

Benefits of Medications to Treat Addiction

Medications for substance use really do make a difference! Most reduce cravings and many medications help you feel like your regular self. These medications can also reduce the risk of overdose, reduce substance use, and help you stay connected to treatment.

Get Started

We offer medications, individual and group counseling, and peer support in English and Spanish (*Hillsboro only*). We can find the combination that best works for you and supports your personal recovery journey. For more information or to discuss your options please call (503) 713-9155. Explore your options for using medications to treat your addiction:

Buprenorphine for opioid use disorder (Commonly known as Suboxone and Subutex and Sublocade)

Naltrexone pills for opioid and alcohol use disorder

Injectable form of naltrexone, called Vivitrol, may be available

Acamprosate (Campral) for alcohol use disorder

New Patients: Accepting new patients from Washington, Clatsop, Columbia and Tillamook counties only, or those who have recently left Fora Withdrawal Management program within the last 3 weeks. Call or walk-in during the above times to get enrolled. We will schedule an appointment with a medical provider as soon as possible, usually within 3 business days.

Established Patients: If you have missed an appointment or need to be seen before your next scheduled appointment: call or walk in during the above hours.
