Medications for substance use really do make a difference! Most reduce cravings and many medications help you feel like your regular self. These medications can also reduce the risk of overdose, reduce substance use, and help you stay connected to treatment.

Insurance

We take most insurance plans – every once in a while, insurance won't cover specific medications, and we'll do all we can to get them covered.

Explore your options for using medications to treat your addiction:

Buprenorphine for opioid use disorder (Commonly known as Suboxone and Subutex and Sublocade)

Naltrexone pills for opioid and alcohol use disorder

Injectable form of naltrexone, called Vivitrol, may be available

Acamprosate (Campral) for alcohol use disorder
