Fora Health saves lives every day from the devastating disease of addiction.

Substance Use Disorder is a chronic, complex, relapsing disease, but with compassionate, individualized, wraparound care, it is treatable. Our evidencebased, culturally responsive programs prepare patients for long-term recovery and success in all aspects of their lives. 55,000 people have received treatment since our founding. With care and compassion, our community is a healthier, stronger, and more vibrant place to call home.

89% of patients feel our services are making a positive difference in their lives




86% of youth patients are from low-income households

*In 2020 we reduced the number of patients in residence to meet COVID-19 safety protocols. When we open our new purpose-built treatment center in Fall 2021 we will triple our patient capacity.





Fora Health, *formerly De Paul Treatment Centers*, provides treatment, care and advocacy for all who are affected by Substance Use Disorder. For nearly 50 years, we have helped individuals and families break harmful cycles, repair relationships and get back to the things that matter. Opened in 1985, Fora Health's Youth & Family Center is one of only four youth residential treatment facilities for Substance Use Disorder in Oregon. Young people in our care receive individual, group and family therapy, mental health services, and work an academic plan at the Fora Health Alternative School.

Together, we are addressing one of our community's greatest needs.

- 1 in 10 Oregonians has a substance use disorder
- Oregon ranks 48th in the nation for prevalence of Substance Use Disorder
- Only 5% of those who need care are treated annually
- 40% increase in overdose deaths in 2020
- Substance Use Disorder costs Oregon tax payers
 \$6.7 billion annually
